MOTION FOR SUBPOENA

- On May 4, 2020 the Independent Ethics Commission ("IEC") issued an Interim Scheduling Order setting the date of the hearing as June 4, 2020.
- On May 22, 2020 Respondent submitted a Motion for Reconsideration of the Commission's May 4, 2020 Interim Scheduling Order.
- In Respondent's motion he stated that he would not agree to participate in a remote video conference hearing and attempted to withdraw from the February 7, 2020 stipulation wherein he agreed to testify.
- 4. On May 26, 2020 Complainant filed a response requesting the IEC require Respondent Hickenlooper to appear and testify. Complainant noted that Respondent had committed to appearing before the Commission to testify in the stipulation on February 7, 2020 and again at the hearing on February 11, 2020. Complainant objected to Respondent now rescinding their prior stipulation and commitment.
- On May 27, 2020 the IEC issued an Interim Order. The Order denied Respondent's Motion to withdraw the stipulation but found that if the Respondent declines to appear, "that is Respondent's prerogative. If Complainant wishes to subpoena Respondent to testify as part of its case in chief, Complainant may do so."
- Without a subpoena Complainant is unable to enforce Respondent's prior commitments to voluntarily testify.
